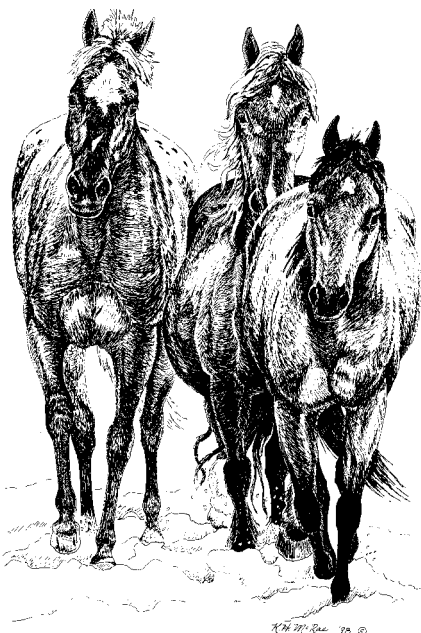
JANUARY 2008 NEWSLETTER
